What Can I Expect? How Do I Remain Safe?

Daily Passive Screening At Home

Staff & Students will be required each morning before arriving to work/school to check their temperature for a fever and monitor for any COVID-19 related symptoms.

Staff will need to check-in by using QR code at their school site location upon arrival
(This will assist with contact tracing in the event of a COVID-19 positive case)

Are You Vaccinated?

CDPH encourages all employees and students (12 years and older) to get vaccinated against the COVID-19 virus
(Enter your vaccinations dates./proof in the [COVID -19 Vaccine Portal](#)).

(Per CalOSHA employees who choose not to submit proof of vaccination employer shall treat the employee as unvaccinated)

Stay Home If Sick

Fever greater than 99.5° (by no-touch thermometer), chills, aches, fatigue, cough, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea or any new loss of taste or smell

Call Supervisor to advise them of your illness/absence

Report your absence in Frontline System

Face Coverings

School sites- Indoors: Face coverings will be required for students & adults regardless of vaccination status except when eating and drinking. Outdoors: Face coverings are optional but encouraged

Hygiene Practices

Frequently wash hands or use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol for 20 seconds

Remember to cover cough and sneezes

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

PPE will continue to be available to students and staff who require them

N-95 masks available following receipt of training and signing an acknowledgment

Disinfecting/ Cleaning

Frequently touched surfaces at offices, classrooms and on school buses will be cleaned daily by trained custodial staff.

In the case of positive exposure, affected office, spaces will be cleaned and disinfected as required.

Remember to clean personal work area at the end of your shift!
