

Mosyle - Apply Heads Up and Get Student Attention

Heads Up allows you to quickly disable student devices to gain attention during a lesson or explanation. Here, you can also customize a message to show on the lock screen of the iPads during the time the devices are disabled.

To apply Heads Up:

- 1. Select Heads Up from the menu on the left
- 2. Customize the message that will be displayed on the screen of student devices
- 3. Click Apply Heads Up

Remember: to use Heads Up, your class will need to already be in progress or you can click Start Class to begin the lesson.

Tip: After entering a message, this will be the default message displayed anytime you access Heads Up until it is changed. This way, it's quick and easy to activate - simply tap the toggle to enable the feature.

Tip: This feature is very useful in a scenario where students are working collaboratively using their iPads. As you monitor group progress, you may notice a few groups asking the same questions. Instead of addressing the same question multiple times to individual groups, you can quickly enable Heads Up to gain the attention of the class, address the question with the entire class, and then release students to continue their work. This way, you can ensure students are focused on instruction without any distractions.
