

## Mosyle - Organize Applications using Study Apps

The Study Apps feature allows you to create a list of allowed apps for each of your classes; customizing app access based on the unique characteristics and needs of each group of students.

Any apps not listed will be hidden from student devices, thus only showing the apps indicated by the teacher in the Study Apps list. In the event one of the applications listed is not installed on student devices, enabling the Study Apps feature will prompt the installation of the app (if permitted by the Mosyle Admin). This restricted list of applications will be applied whether you are only using Mosyle Manager to manage your student devices, or if you are using both Mosyle Manager and the Classroom app.

### To create your list of Study Apps:

- **1.** Select Study Apps from the menu on the left
- **2.** Click the **“Add application(s) to the list”** button at the bottom
- **3.** Choose to add applications from the App Store, Native Apps (apps that are factory-installed on the devices), and/or apps purchased through your school's VPP account.
- **4.** Search for the name of the app in the Search field
- **5.** Click **“Choose”** to select the app(s)
- **6.** After selecting the desired study app(s) click Save

If you change your mind and would like to delete an application from the list, click the X in the top right corner of the app icon.

Additionally, students can see and access this list of Study Apps through the Self-Service page in the Mosyle Manager app. This is a great way to provide students with an easy way to access the apps needed to complete coursework. From this screen, students can also request to install, reinstall or update any of the Study Apps as needed.

Use the toggle on the left to enable Study Apps. Remember: in order to enable this feature, you must have already Started the Class.

**Tip:** *To optimize your time in the classroom, take time to pre-select applications for your Study Apps list. Feel free to do this during the time you're planning your lessons. That way, all that's left is to push a single button to manage app access on student iPads during the class.*

**Tip:** *Any app(s) listed in Study Apps that are not installed on the devices will be automatically installed. If the app was selected from the App Store, and is not already installed on the devices, students will be prompted to enter their Apple ID and password to complete the download. If the app was selected from VPP, and is not already installed on the devices, it will silently install on the devices without any user interaction. As a good practice, we recommend that all apps be installed on the student iPads prior to the start of class. To do this, ask for help from your school's Mosyle Administrator.*
