What is the process to begin using Lexia?

1. ORCs at each site will work with parents to explain Core (K-5) or Power Up (6-8)-*depending on their children’s grade level* and to provide login support as needed.
2. In order to assure that students are placed in the correct level based on the students’ auto placement results student data will be cleared on August 21st.
3. Students need to complete an auto placement during a synchronous meeting prior to using the program during independent time
4. After the auto placement is complete, students can begin using Core 5 or Power Up during independent learning
5. Teachers will receive training on the program (reports, access to resources) on Wednesday, September 2, 2020. The training is approximately 90 minutes. A timecard for 30 minutes will be provided to teachers who participate in the full 90 meeting training.

Login with Clever

1. Launch the Clever app.
2. If you do not have a clever badge, log-in with Oxnard SD username (next to the Clever Logo)
*First time they sign in, students will need to search for the school
3. Students will be logged into the class portal (Students will see icons for ST Math and Lexia)
4. Select Lexia

1. The very first time your child logs in to Core5 they should be in a virtual classroom with their teacher where they will take a short placement test. Please encourage them to do their best but **do not provide any support**.
2. It is important that your child works **without any help while using Core5**. All of the work your child does at home is recorded and reported to the school.
