## School Wide Behavior Expectations



At Juan Lagunas Soria, we strive to maintain a positive environment where students and staff enjoy school and treat each other with mutual respect. All teachers follow the school-wide behavior plan in their classrooms because we believe: that all students have the right to learn, and all teachers have the right to teach. We believe that all students have the potential for making good choices and behaving in a positive manner. To this end, we have developed the following behavior expectations and discipline plan.

Students and parents, please read the following.

### **Drop Off:**

Students can arrive at 7:45 AM through the front gate and 8:00 am through the back gate when supervision begins.

Upon arrival through the front gate, students should go to the cafeteria for breakfast and then to the blacktop after 8:00 am to play.

### **Pick Up:**

Students must exit the building after school by going outside and not walking through the school hallways. Kindergarten students are released from the kindergarten gates at the front of the school. 1st and 2nd-grade students are released from the flagpole gate on Dunkirk St. 3rd through 8th-grade students are released from the blacktop Dunkirk gate and are not allowed to play on the structure after school. They must immediately exit the school.

### **Cell Phones:**

Cell Phones may be brought to school but must be turned off and placed in students' backpacks until the conclusion of the school day. All calls need to be made through the office.

### **Bicycle/Skateboard/Scooter Rules:**

1. Helmets must be worn to and from school.
2. Bicycles, Skateboards, and Scooters must be walked on school premises. Sidewalks must be used while in the parking lot areas. Electric Scooters (and anything not student-powered) are not to be ridden to school for safety reasons.
3. Bicycles, scooters, and skateboards must be parked in the bike, scooter, and skateboard area. It is recommended that students lock up their transportation, however, the school will be locked during the school day.
4. One person only on a bike.
5. If under grade three, the student must be accompanied by an adult for safety.
6. Bicycles, skateboards, and scooters may not be used on campus.

**Student behavior consequences:**

1. Truant (Without a pass out of class) Yellow to office and green to bathroom
2. 3 tardies = lunch detention
3. Vaping = intervention classes, parent conference, and/or suspension
4. Non-dress = 3 or more is lunch detention
5. Cell Phone = 1st time is a warning, 2nd time gets taken away, the 3rd time parent has to pick up and conference
6. Earbuds = 1st time is a warning, 2nd time gets taken away, the 3rd time parent has to pick up and conference
7. Fighting = suspension 3-5 days and contract
8. Weapons = suspension and/or recommendation for expulsion
9. Foul Language = detention
10. Dress Code = must change into Soria T-shirt and/or parents bring a change of clothes. Repeat offenses result in suspension.
11. Inappropriate physical contact with other students = 1st time warning, 2nd time will result in a parent conference.
