- I. **Call the meeting to order** (*Llamar la junta al orden*) at 3:05pm.

Others in attendance: Diana Pelayo (Intermediate School Secretary).
- III. **Call for any additions/deletions of agenda items** (*Nombrar cualquier adición/omisión de artículos en la agenda*). There were no additions or deletions to the agenda.
- IV. **Reading and approval of the minutes** (*Lectura y aprobación del acta de reunión*). Changes were noted to the role call of members. Mr. Hess moved to approve the meeting minutes. Alvarez seconded the motion. All were in favor.
- V. **Discussion** (*Platica*)
 1. First read of Comprehensive School Safety Plan (*Primer repaso del Plan Integral de Seguridad Escolar, CSSP*) Dr. Santamaría provided a brief overview of the CSSP. He also shared a draft of Hybrid Model Map for the School Re-Opening to provide the committee with a visual of how arrival/dismissal may work for when students return for in-person instruction. Since the CSSP does not go into a lot of detail related to a School Re-Opening for the Hybrid Model, a mini parent

handbook will most likely need to be created in order to inform parents and students of the safety procedures and protocols that will need to be followed. Ms. Gomez suggested to create videos to show students and parents how to drop off/pick up students and to show students how to navigate the campus to get to their classrooms while practicing social distancing.

VI. Action Items (*Artículos de Acción*):

1. **Approval of the 2020-21 Parent and Family Engagement Policy (*Aprobación de la Política de Participación Para Padres y Familias*).** Dr. Santamaría explained the changes that were made to the original draft with regards to Middle School progress reports. Mr. Hess moved to approved the 2020-21 Parent and Family Engagement Policy. Ms. Magana seconded. All were in favor. The policy was approved.

VII. Report of committees/officers/principal (*Reporte del comité/oficiales/director*)

1. **ELAC/DELAC report (*Reporte de ELAC/DELAC*).** Dr. Santamaría shared that during the last ELAC meeting, parents expressed their frustrations and anxiety around the negative impacts of Distance Learning on students' academic and social/emotional wellbeing. Ms. Magana, who facilitates an ELAC parent support group on Fridays, shared that, after helping parents better understand the state's requirements for Distance Learning, parents were more at ease with the level of supports the school has been providing to students.
2. **Principal's Report (*Reporte del Director*).** Dr. Santamaria discussed that hopefully more information will be provided to staff and families with regards to the School Re-opening. He wished the group a Happy Holidays. In February, he indicated that he will facilitate a review of the SPSA once mid-year Star 360 data has been collected.
3. **Assistant Principal's Report (*Reporte de la Subdirectora*) Counselor's Report (*Reporte de la Consejera*).** Ms. Magana reported on behalf of the Assistant Principal and the School Counselor an update on 6th – 8th grade student conferences for students receiving Ds or Fs.
4. **ORC Report (*Reporte de la Especialista de Recursos Sociales*).** Ms. Magana reporte don Operation Schoolbell (resources provided to 20 students per site). In addition, there will be 8 families receiving resources from Driscolls. Soria families have adopted 5 Soria families to provide resources during the holidays. Toys for Tots will also be potentially donating toys for families in need. Ms. Magana also reported that she and the School Counselor will be coordinating Study Halls for Grades 3-5 students to support homework

completion. She and the counselor will be adding lunch bunches for students to increase opportunities for social interaction. Ms. Magana is also facilitating an ELAC parent support group to have informal conversations to identify ways to support parents and meet family needs. She is looking to offer grade level-specific support meetings for parents.
